- I Call to Order by Denise Guiney, PTA Secretary, at 7:06pm.
- II Opening Remarks – Two board members were unable to attend; welcome to guest speaker Jim LeMunyon.
- III Addition/changes to agenda – Allison McArthur motioned to approve the agenda as presented. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously with no changes.
- IV Approval of April 2014 PTA Meeting Minutes – Shelby Oakley motioned to approve the April minutes as presented. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
- V Guest Speaker – Delegate Jim LeMunyon
 - A. He spoke about the budget.
 - 1) Budget is not yet finished, one issue that is still to be resolved.
 - 2) Amount of money to the county has been increasing in the past years and will increase again in the future.
 - 3) This year and next Fairfax County will get the biggest checks ever received.
 - B. Five SOL tests have been eliminated beginning next year – science & social studies in 3rd grade, writing in 5th and 2 histories (1 in middle school and 1 in 5th or 6th).
 - C. The school calendar and giving the districts the power to choose the school start day is still a favorable topic in the House. It passed in the House but was not given a hearing in the Senate sub - committee. Travel and tourism have an impact on this – they want the families to visit the popular vacation destinations during the week before Labor Day.
 - D. Will be repaving streets in and around Sully Park Drive.
